### Stewarding Regional Health Transformation

This useful *ReThink Health* guide revolves around building a **Stewardship Team**: groups of well-positioned leaders who are willing and able to take responsibility for improving their system of health broadly and who lead together on behalf of that system, not just their own organizations.

It identifies **three core pillars** of the pathway transformation: **1) broad-based stewardship 2) sound strategy 3) sustainable financing** and includes a discussion of **common pitfalls and momentum builders**.

It includes a useful tool, **Mapping the Scope of Your Efforts**, to consider to what degree you are pursuing regional health system transformation. Who else needs to be involved? Among other aspects, the first section helps evaluate your efforts' level of emphasis across the spectrum of downstream and upstream health factors and on sustainably financing your health system.
