Now that the May 15th deadline for H2O fund requests has passed, it is time to start celebrating the CHIO success of healthy hearts-cardiovascular initiatives across Oklahoma counties! We look forward to sharing these initiative highlights in the weeks ahead!

The Tri-CHIO coordinated the purchase, packaging and delivery of supplies for participating practices in Grant, Garfield and Alfalfa Counties. Each of the eight participating practices received funds toward blood pressure cuffs, monitoring kits for patients with diabetes, monitoring kits for congestive heart failure, transportation passes (through the local public transportation system) and/or the option to spend up to \$1000 for an item of their choice.
