The awardees include several CHIO represented counties including Sand Springs Community in **Tulsa** County, Antlers community in **Pushmataha** County and the Okeene Elementary School in **Blaine** county. As part of a comprehensive effort to reduce obesity and tobacco use in Oklahoma children, these grants were awarded to communities and schools with key prevention strategies. Stay tuned to these counties, and the other awardees, to learn more about their partnerships, methods to leverage additional funding and outcomes of their health promotion efforts.
